

promises, as well as in covenants, there is a necessity of a mutual consent unto the same thing; the party to whom the promise is made, his acceptance thereof being necessary to complete the obligation on the promiser to make it effectual.”

I hope that we can follow Boston's reasoning because it is of utmost importance if we are to understand the form for the administration of baptism. God's promises were offered to all Israel. Boston says that those who fell in the wilderness had not been excluded from God's promise concerning Canaan; rather, they did not enter because of their unbelief. ~Rev. C Harinck
